

FRUITLAND LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

The Fruitland, Iowa Community Lions Club is offering a scholarship of \$500 for a graduating senior at L-M High School. The emphasis for the award is on the amount of volunteer public/community service the student does during his or her four years of high school, in particular, senior year.

Consideration will be weighted as 75% on community service, 25% on financial need. The Fruitland Community Lions Club will do the judging and evaluation of the essay and selects the winner, verifying that the activity qualifies as public or community volunteer service, such as work with a food pantry. Volunteering does not need to be in the L-M School District.

Those who feel they qualify for the award must submit the following:

- 1) Completed Application
- 2) List of volunteer/community service
- 3) Essay including specifics of the volunteer work performed -- why the student was involved, work completed, problems overcome, and the effect the work had on others.
Do not include student name in the essay
- 4) Letter of reference from someone who supervised the service
